



Type Rating Instructor (MPA) Training

Course Structure:

- Ground School: Classroom work covering theoretical aspects of instruction.
- Simulator: Technical training and examination in the full flight simulator, available at different locations, depending on availability.
- Aircraft Training: This will require six landings on the aircraft and takes about one hour of flying.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 1500 hrs on multi-crew aircraft
- Valid Type Rating on the applicable aircraft
- Within the last 12 month flown 30 route sectors on the applicable aircraft type, as PIC or Co-pilot
